Library Services

Interlibrary loan service is available for patrons with requests for items that cannot be found in our library. If we don't have it, we will try to get it for you from another public library.

For patron use, the library has 10 public access computers available which are equipped with word processing, database, spreadsheet, and presentation software, and are connected to the internet.

The library offers access to the Michigan e-library. MeL includes a statewide library catalog, commercial databases purchased by the Library of Michigan, various digital collections, and a collection of internet links organized by subject.

The library offers its meeting room(s) to public groups wishing to present programs or to hold meetings which serve the community's needs.

The library maintains a separate collection of children and young adult books and materials. Throughout the summer, as well as during the school year, the library has very active children and young adult programs. For more information, please contact our Children's Librarian.

A photocopier is available for use in the library, at a charge of 20 cents for 8 $^{1}/_{2}$ x 11 and legal-size, and 30 cents for reductions, enlargements and 11 x 17 copies.

Children's and Young Adult Books

The library maintains a separate collection of books for children and young adults. The children and young adult collections make up roughly 34% of the entire library collection.
